Term Two Week 3 Grade 1 and 2

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

Welcome to Week 3. Last week in Investigations we looked at how we are living in our homes during Covid 19, this week we are continuing to think about our homes and how we live in them.

Session One

Literacy: In literacy, we are continuing to learn about writing information reports.

Each literacy session will start with reading a book of choice and completing the book response included in the pack. These are the same as last week, so students can increase their independence with each task. We have also added one vocabulary, grammar, punctuation and handwriting task for the week.

Each day students will complete a reading comprehension task about an animal. Please give support if needed, as it is difficult for us to set this reading task to match each student's reading level. For writing, the students will be working on another animal information report. They will spend three days planning, researching and writing their information. This week they can present their information as a poster. There is a piece of A3 paper in their pack, if needed. On Monday they can write a recount of their weekend and Friday a free choice writing session.

Session Two

Numeracy: We are focusing number facts to 20 and adding larger numbers. During the week we will post two videos on Class DoJo to explain some of thinking strategies they need to learn. Students have a warm up and problem solving activity and worksheets to complete.

There is also a small maths game included in the pack. Once these are finished, students can spend some time on Study Ladder or Essential Assessment Sunshine Maths activities.

Please remember to check Class Dojo regularly. We will continue video will be posted in the morning and students will have tasks to complete throughout the day. Once students have completed tasks they will receive a dojo point and it helps us will following up attendance.
