


HOME LEARNING PROGRAM

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

Our last week of home learning! YAY! We are so excited to have students back in the classroom. We have been very pleased with the way students and families have adapted to the situation and are very thankful for everyone's support during the last six weeks. This week there is no work set for Wednesday as it is a much-needed wellbeing day for students, parents and teachers, so enjoy a well-deserved break.

Literacy: This week we are continuing to focus on narrative texts. The reading topics are all narrative texts. In writing time, the students will start to plan a new narrative. Students can also use this week to make adjustments and continue working on narrative from last week. The writing process is broken into steps again but this can be adjusted if your child would like to move through the steps faster and spend more time writing the story.

Mathematics: We are continuing with the money topic this week. It is very useful to use money or play money when solving money problems. Extension questions have been set to further challenge learning. If these are too hard, parents can modify to suit their child.

In Investigations we are moving onto researching and learning about the state of New South Wales. Activities are similar to last week but focusing on a different state.

The usual Art, Library, PE and Wellbeing tasks are attached.

Please keep checking Class DoJo and contributing to their portfolios. Remember to listen to the daily stories read by 1/2 students and please send us a video of your child reading if you haven't already.

Look on Dojo class story for a welcome video from your teacher.	<p>Literacy 45-60 minutes Reading: Silent independent reading or read aloud to an adult for 15 minutes. Complete the main character sheet. Draw a picture and four important facts about the character. This sheet can be done based on the book you are reading or the comprehension text you read. Complete narrative reading comprehension task. Read the text and answer the comprehension questions. Listen to story on Dojo read by a student in the 1/2 classes.</p> <p>Grammar: Complete Adjectives activity. Adjectives are describing words. This are very important to use regularly in narrative writing.</p> <p>Writing: This week we are writing narratives again. Today think about and plan a character, problem, solution and the setting that will be included in your narrative. Complete the planners.</p> <p>Spelling: Watch spelling video on class dojo of spelling lesson. Complete a spelling activity of choice from spelling activity sheet.</p>	<p>Mathematics 30-45 minutes Warm up activity: How many ways can you make 60 cents? Draw each way.</p> <p>Extension problem solving question: Kate ordered a sandwich (\$6.70) and a cup of tea (\$3.50). How much did she pay for both?</p> <p>Charlotte bought three jars of strawberry jam each costing \$3.50. How much did Charlotte spend?</p> <p>Board game: Another board game has been made by Mrs Lake to be used as often as you like.</p> <p>Task: Drawing a coin. Put a coin under paper and colour with crayon over the top.</p>	<p>Art activity: Complete art lesson planned by Ms Bentley.</p>

Complete the sequencing activity by drawing a picture and writing about the different events in the story. This sheet can be done based on the book you are reading or the comprehension text you read. Complete narrative reading comprehension task. Read the text and answer the comprehension questions. Listen to story on Dojo read by a student in the 1/2 classes.</p> <p>Handwriting: Complete the handwriting activity. Letter Ee.</p> <p>Writing: Use the Story Map in your booklet to complete your plan for your narrative writing.</p> <p>Spelling: Look, say, cover, write and check with spelling words on work sheet. Complete a spelling activity of choice from spelling activity sheet.</p>	<p>Mathematics 30-45 minutes Maths warm up activity: Order coins from lowest in value to highest value and draw in book.</p> <p>Extension problem solving question: Calculate the total cost of a box of fruit that consists of a watermelon (\$5.20), oranges (\$2.20), apples (\$2.50), strawberries (\$5.50) and grapes (\$3.40)?</p> <p>Mason bought a sheet of fish stickers for \$1.10, a sheet of dolphin stickers for \$1.10 and a sheet of racing car stickers for \$2.10. How much did Mason spend in all?</p> <p>Written Task: Cut and paste coloured money sheet. Cut and paste into workbook to match amount.</p>	<p>PE activity Youtube kids app Find the PE with Joe channel. These videos have PE activities to follow.</p> <p>Library activity: Complete lesson planned by Mrs McLaren. This lesson will be available in class dojo stories as it has links attached.</p>

Look on Dojo class story for a welcome video from your teacher.	<p>Literacy 45-60 minutes Reading: Silent independent reading or read aloud to an adult for 15 minutes. Complete the book review activity and answer all the questions about your opinion of the text. Complete narrative reading comprehension task. Read the text and answer the comprehension questions. Listen to story on Dojo read by a student in the 1/2 classes.</p> <p>Punctuation: Complete punctuation activity.</p> <p>Writing: Now you have completed your plan with your characters, setting and problem, it's time to write! Before you start writing, video yourself talking about your story. Recording your ideas can help you to remember details and sequence your story. If you get stuck while you are writing, you can look back at your video.</p> <p>Spelling: Look, say, cover, write and check with spelling words on work sheet. Complete a spelling activity of choice from spelling activity sheet.</p>	<p>Mathematics 30-45 minutes Warm up: Give 5 different ways of making \$10 with coins.</p> <p>Extension problem solving question: Lachlan earns \$25 an hour. How much does he earn in 5 hours?</p> <p>Henry earned \$5 for each lawn he mowed. If he had 10 lawns to mow, but forgot to mow 2 of them, how much money did he actually earn?</p> <p>Written Task: Complete maths activities in booklet. If you have time complete some set tasks on Study Ladder or maths seeds.</p>	<p>PE activity: Youtube kids app Find the Kidzbop dance along channel. These videos have different songs to select with dance moves to follow.</p> <p>Investigations/Geography 45 minutes Mark on the New South Wales map some towns or cities that you know of. They might be where some of your family live, places you have been too or places that you know about. Do some research to find out where they are located in New South Wales.</p> <p>Work on the New South Wales activity and colour in the flag, map, coat of arms and floral emblem. Do some research to find out more about these and to find out what colour they are.</p>

Look on Dojo class story for a welcome video from your teacher.	<p>Literacy 45-60 minutes Reading: Silent independent reading or read aloud to an adult for 15 minutes. Film a video review of a book that you have been reading. In the video explain what you liked about the book, what could have been better, the best part of the book, how many stars out of 10 you would give the book and anything else that you would like to add about the book. Complete narrative reading comprehension task. Read the text and answer the comprehension questions. Listen to story on Dojo read by a student in the 1/2 classes.</p> <p>Writing: Keep working on your story. Try to follow your plan and check your video if you have forgotten your story.</p> <p>Spelling: Look, say, cover, write and check with spelling words on work sheet. <i>Spelling test</i> with an adult at home. Adult reads word and student writes it down. Correct at end and send a picture on class dojo student portfolio.</p>	<p>Mathematics 30-45 minutes Warm up: Give 5 different ways of making \$8 dollars in coins.</p> <p>Extension problem solving question: Molly had no money. She then withdrew \$50 from the ATM. She bought a new book for \$10, spent \$8 on lunch and paid \$12 for a new bag. How much money does Molly have left?</p> <p>Sally had a box of chocolates to sell to raise money for her dance school. Each chocolate in the box cost \$3. If the box had 7 chocolates total and Sally sold 5 of them, how much money did she make?</p> <p>Written Task: Complete maths activities in booklet. If you have time complete some set tasks on Study Ladder or maths seeds.</p>	<p>PE activity: Free choice movement break activity</p> <p>Investigations/ Geography 45 minutes: Complete the All About New South Wales sheet. This will involve some research.</p> <p>Wellbeing activity: Complete wellbeing activity in pack.</p>
