HOME LEARNING PROGRAM

Term Three Week 6 starting 17 August

Hi Everyone,

Welcome to Week 6. This week we are continuing with similar units of work. Thank you for keeping up with the videos and sending in your work on Class Dojo.

My aim is to create a program that enables each student to complete tasks independently, however, to make it challenging and fun, there are times when your child may need some support.

- Encourage your child to be as independent as possible. Get them to read their daily planner and tick off each completed task.
- At school, they do not have constant support for their learning, so they are used to thinking on their own and working through problems.
- We learn best from our own discoveries and achievements.
 The trick with teaching is asking questions, rather than

providing an answer.

- After they have finished a task, check-in with them.
- Congratulate them on their effort and independence.
- Discuss one or two aspects of their work and ask them about their thinking. Be encouraging and end with a positive comment.

Literacy: We are continuing to learn about procedure texts in writing and reading. These texts help students to communicate about everyday practices, using direct and specific language.

Mathematics: We will learn about how shapes can be moved, will use specific language to give directions and learn about maps. The topic is Location.

Thanks to the students who have had a go on Mathletics. It's a great program for home learning, as students can progress at their own level and repeat topics to develop their understanding.

Investigations - This week we are focusing on the moon. We will learn about phases of the moon and how the influences life on Earth. We will also compare gravity on the moon to that on Earth. Unfortunately, there is a new moon this Wednesday, so there may not be much to see.
