Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

I hope you all had a great weekend. Welcome to week 6 term 3. It was great to have so many students tuning into Webex session and posting their work regularly on class dojo last week. This week we will continue to have Webex whole class sessions on Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 9:15am. The meeting number and password, as well as topic of conversation will be in the daily planner. It is important for students to tune into these sessions as we will discuss requirements for different activities. Guided reading sessions will continue as well and will be the same day each week. Please check reading planning table in the planner to see which day you have guided reading or what activity you are required to do on each day. Please make sure you follow the planner daily and check to see if the lesson has a video included. Each video is a short instruction of the lesson that will make each task more clear before beginning your work.

For writing we are continuing to write procedure text on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. This week students will have be able to choose what they write about. We will have this discussion on Monday at 9:15am and daily writing lessons will be posted on class dojo.

Maths this week we are focusing on location, position, turns, slides and flips. Each worksheet focuses on this topic. Each day there is also warm up and a problem solving question which isn't on this topic but is a good start for the maths lesson to get your brain thinking about different maths topics.

Earth and Space Science on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday this week is learning about the Moon. On Wednesday we will have a discussion about the Moon and further discuss what is required for this week's focus.

Movement breaks are very important during the day. Make sure you have a break 2 or 3 times in the day and get outside and move your body. On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday I have put examples of movement breaks to do but make sure you do something every day to help keep your brain active. Hope you have a fantastic week and please message me on dojo if you have any questions.
