Term Three Week 5

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,



For Remote Learning 2.0, I have placed worksheets in plastic folders. This might be a harder to use, but it allows me to give children more individualised work. The green folder, worksheets and work books need to be returned to the lockers under the BV at the end of each week - just like last time.

Please make sure your child watches the DOJO video lessons each day. Get them to watch the Literacy videos before reading/writing/spelling activities and the Maths video before they complete their maths work. I am hoping that this support will enable them to be more independent. I will put the videos up before 9am.

Literacy: This week we are starting to learn about procedure texts. These are texts that give instructions about how to do something. Some of the reading topics are examples of procedure texts. Other examples of procedure texts will be set on Reading Eggs.

In writing time on Monday, the students will copy a procedure text about making a sandwich and on Tuesday they will plan a procedure about 'How to plant a bean seed' or a topic of their own choice. They will work towards presenting a finished piece of writing by the end of the week. Daily Dojo videos will support the steps in the writing process.

Mathematics: We are revisiting the topic SHAPE. We are learning more about the features of both 2D and 3D shapes. More activities on SHAPE are available on Mathletics.

Investigations - Follow the instructions (procedure) to make a diorama about a habitat on Earth. You will need a small box, glue, paper and pencils.

Students will be asked to submit samples of their work each day, in their portfolio on ClassDojo Art and Library activities will be posted on DoJo by Miss Bentley and Mrs McLaren.
